Award Guidelines



Mahmood Merican Best Masters Research Award

This is an annual award for the best original scientific or clinical paper submitted by postgraduate Orthopaedic trainees in Malaysia. This work represents the research that was conducted during training, which is one of the requirements for the conferment of their degree. This award was initiated in 1997 by Dato' Dr Mahmood Merican, whom the award is named after. He is a wellknown Orthopaedic Surgeon and a philantrophist who has contributed tremendously to the Malaysian Orthopaedic community. The objective of the award is to encourage a high standard of research and scientific presentation among Orthopaedic trainees so they may become surgeons who can perform great surgery but are themselves thinkers who understand the importance of sound scientific work and its applicability in daily clinical practice.

This award has demonstrated good outcomes and each year the competition gets tougher. We wish all the applicants Good Luck!

The Prize

A cash prize of **RM3,000.00** donated by Dato' Dr Mahmood Merican.

Regulations

- The competition is open to all registered trainees in the Malaysian Orthopaedic Post-graduate training programmes in Malaysian universities and trainees who have completed or will complete their training in 2024 are also eligible.
- 2. The work may take the form of clinical trials, surveys, retrospective studies, laboratory experiments or any other form of original work.
- 3. In general, the research work must be derived from a thesis / dissertation completed during the time of training. Published work by a trainee can also be accepted provided they can show evidence that the work was submitted as a requirement for the Masters of Orthopaedic Surgery (or similar programme).
- 4. Applicants should not have submitted similar work in any other competition, including for this award previously. The research work must not have been presented in whole or in part in any form in other conferences, seminars, or official presentations.
- The abstract will be evaluated on the following criteria:-
 - » The relevance of the work to Orthopaedic research or practice.
 - » The scientific merit of the research.
 - » Sufficient introduction to justify clear research question.
 - » The appropriateness of the methodologies used.
 - » The interpretation of results and conclusions.
 - » Presentation skills.
 - » Ability to answer questions from the judges.

- 6. Upon the abstract submission deadline, all abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and be scored by a group of selected International Orthopaedic surgeons to shortlist the top 5 finalists. All authors will be notified of the status of their paper.
- All results are final; however, the scientific committee
 has the right to make the final decision in special
 circumstances.
- 8. The top 5 finalists will be provided with complimentary registration to the 53rd MOA ASM 2024.
- The submitting authors of the top 5 finalist submissions must present an oral presentation of the paper during the MOA Annual Scientific Meeting. This consists of 8 minutes oral presentation, followed by 4 minutes of Q&A with the panel of judges.
- All applicants may request for the detailed results of the submission after the competition is over, provided it is approved by the Scientific Committee.
- Non-finalists may be offered a chance to present their work as a free paper oral presentation or poster presentation during the MOA Annual Scientific Meeting.
- 12. All finalists and non-finalists presenting in MOA Annual Scientific Meeting must register for the conference as a delegate.
- 13. All finalists will be invited to the MOA President's Dinner. The winner will be announced during the dinner and the winner must be present to accept the award.

Award Guidelines



Best Basic Science Poster Award

This award is open to all scientists regardless of origin or levels, provided the research is related to the field of basic science in orthopaedics. This award was created more than 6 years ago to increase the participation of scientists in orthopaedic related research work in Malaysia. It is hoped that by doing so, MOA is encouraging more people to engage in serious research work, purely driven at understanding the very fundamentals of sciences that have enormous impact on orthopaedic practices. This award is generously donated in full by Dato' Dr K.S. Sivananthan, who is a veteran, a Past President of MOA and esteemed member of the MOA and patron of this award since its inception.

The Prize

A cash prize of **RM1,000.00** donated by Dato' Dr K.S. Sivananthan.

Regulations

- This award is open to all scientists regardless of origin or levels provided the research is related to the field of orthopaedics (based on the interpretation of the scientific committee.)
- 2. Abstract submitted for this award should be an unpublished original orthopaedic related research (lab study). Systemic reviews are not accepted.
- The bulk of the work submitted must be performed by the author even though the author may have done the work in conjunction with other doctors or agencies either locally or internationally. However, the work must be carried out in Malaysia.
- 4. The abstract will be evaluated on the following
 - » The relevance of the work to orthopaedic research or practice.
 - » The scientific merit of the research.
 - » Sufficient introduction to justify clear research question.
 - » The appropriateness of the methodologies used.
 - » The interpretation of results and conclusions.
 - » Presentation skills.
 - » Ability to answer questions from the judges.

- 5. Upon the abstract submission deadline, all abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and be scored by a selected group of judges to shortlist the top 5 finalists. All authors will be notified of the status of their paper.
- All results are final; however the scientific committee
 has the right to make the final decision during special
 circumstances.
- The author of a top 5 finalist abstract must prepare a poster presentation during the MOA Annual Scientific Meeting. Finalists will be provided with complimentary registrations to the 53rd MOA ASM 2024.
- 8. The poster presentation judging will be at the poster panels. The assigned time for each finalist will be informed closer to the conference date.
- All finalists and non-finalists presenting in MOA Annual Scientific Meeting must register for the conference as a delegate.
- All finalists will be invited to the MOA President's Dinner. The winner will be announced during the dinner and the winner must be present to accept the award.

Subir Sengupta Best Published Clinical Paper Award & P. Balasubramaniam Best Published Translational Medicine (Non-Clinical) Paper Award

The Malaysian Orthopaedic Association (MOA) has 2 awards to recognise the best published journal papers in the preceding year by members of our associations. The aim of these awards is to promote research and publication culture among MOA members and to recognise their contributions in the field of orthopaedics. The following 2 annual awards are opened to Malaysian orthopaedic surgeons who continue to do research and publish their work in orthopaedic journals.

SUBIR SENGUPTA BEST PUBLISHED CLINICAL PAPER AWARD

This award is to recognise the best published clinical paper for journal papers published in the period from 1st January 2023 to 31st December 2023 in either hardcopy or online journal.

P.BALASUBRAMANIAM BEST PUBLISHED TRANSLATIONAL MEDICINE (NON-CLINICAL) PAPER AWARD

This award is to recognise the best published translational medicine paper for journal papers published in the period from 1st January 2023 to 31st December 2023 in either hardcopy or online journal.

The Prize

A cash prize of **RM2,000.00** for Subir Sengupta Best Published Clinical Paper Award.

A cash prize of **RM2,000.00** for P.Balasubramaniam Best Published Translational Medicine (Non-Clinical) Paper Award.

The cash prizes are donated by Yayasan Ortopedik, Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, Faculty of Medicine, Universiti Malaya.

Criteria

- Originality and level of scientific evidence of the study.
- Potential impact towards medical science and medical practice especially in the field of orthopaedics and trauma.

Eligibility

- 1. The submitter must be the presenter of the award.
- 2. The submitter must be a Malaysian Orthopaedic Surgeon, and one of the authors and key researcher of the paper.
- Journal papers published in the period from 1st January 2023 to 31st December 2023 in either hardcopy or online journal will be eligible.
- 4. Journal paper submitted "in press" will not be eligible.
- Journals papers that were considered before for past Subir Sengupta Best Published Clinical paper Award and P. Balasubramaniam Best Published Translational Medicine (Non Clinical) Paper Award are not eligible for resubmission.
- Authors of award winners will be required to present their paper during the MOA Annual Scientific Meeting to be eligible for the cash prizes. Award winners will be notified beforehand. Winners will be provided with complimentary registrations to the 53rd MOA ASM 2024.
- The award winners will be required to present their papers in a 15 minutes oral presentation during the MOA Annual Scientific Meeting.

- PDF copy of the paper must be submitted online before 2359hrs, 29th February 2024.
- A selection committee will be formed by the Malaysian Orthopaedic Association to evaluate all submissions and winner for each award will be announced before the conference

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstract Template

- Please use the abstract template for spacing and organisation of subsections. (Abstract that does not adhere to the abstract template will not be accepted for review).
- Abstract template can be downloaded from the website.

Abstract Content

Depending on whether your abstract is a Research based abstract or a Case Report, the body follows the following format.

Abstract Guideline

- Must not exceed 350 words including title and references.
- 2. Restricted to only ONE page.
- 3. Font size: 12.
- 4. Font Type: Times New Roman.
- Spacing and Alignment: Single spacing and justified fields
- 6. Figure / Table: Up to 3 figures including graphs and tables, etc. are allowed in each abstract. (The font size within the figures must be clearly visible and must not be less than size 10).
- 7. Format Layout: 2-column page.
- 8. Margin: 0.75" (1.9cm) margin.
- 9. If the abstract contains identifiers e.g. name of hospital in the text body, the authors need to underline them in order for the secretariat to omit them when it is send for evaluation.
- 10. File submitted must be in word document not more than 2.5MB.



Frequently Asked Questions

Must The Submitter and the Presenter be the same person?

Yes, the submitter and presenter must be the same.

Can I submit more than 1 abstract?

Yes, you may submit more than 1 abstract. The account login you create will allow you to submit multiple abstracts.

Which email should I use to create the account?

When you create your account, the email you use should be the same email for all correspondence and e-certificates to be delivered to. For Malaysians, please use the same email address which you use for your CPD points.

What happens if I want to amend my abstracts after I have submitted?

You may amend your abstracts until the 29th February 2024, after which you will not be able to amend your abstract anymore. The responsibility is on the abstract submitter to ensure that the contents uploaded into the abstract is correct and have been proofread for errors.

What Happens After Abstract Submission Deadline Closes?

- All abstracts will be reviewed by the 53rd MOA ASM 2024 Scientific Committee.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to select the abstracts relevant to the sessions and decide on the final form of presentation.
- 3. The results will be announced after the 1st April 2024.
- 4. All successful abstract submitters and award finalists must complete the registration process on their online account before the 20th April 2024 to qualify and present during the meeting.

- The work must be original and must not have been presented in conferences or published previously with the exception of Subir Sengupta Best Published Clinical Paper Award and P. Balasubramaniam Best Published Translational Medicine (Non Clinical) Paper Award.
- If you wish to be considered for any of the Awards, please refer to the rules and regulations for the specific award.
- 4. Do note that successfully accepted abstracts will be published in the supplementary issues of Malaysian Orthopaedic Journal (ISSN 1985-2533) unless informed by the applicant that he/she does not want the abstract to be published there.
- 5. All materials accepted for publication in MOJ will become the permanent property of the Journal. The journal allows readers to read, download, copy, print, search and distribute the published articles, provided the authors are property acknowledged and cited.
- For those who agree to their abstracts being published in the supplementary issue of MOJ, the successful applicants may be required to resubmit the abstract and high-resolution figures for publication at a later time
- 7. Applicants may choose not to have that abstract published in the supplementary issue of MOJ.
- 8. During online submission of abstracts, you will be given the opportunity to indicate if you wish for this submission to be published or not published in the supplementary issue of MOJ.
